Dear Families,

The Simcoe County District School Board (SCDSB) will be changing attendance areas for some Barrie secondary schools. The new attendance areas will take effect in September 2016.

This attendance area review is taking place because of the closure of Barrie Central Collegiate Institute in June 2016 and to determine the attendance area for the new secondary school that is being built in south Barrie. It will also help to balance enrolment at secondary schools in Barrie.

The proposed changes include the attendance areas for Barrie North Collegiate Institute and Innisdale Secondary School. The regular attendance areas and elementary feeder schools for Eastview and Bear Creek secondary schools are not expected to be impacted by the review. The map on the back of this letter shows the proposed changes.

Recommendations for the relocation of the Extended French program that is currently located at Barrie Central will also be determined as part of the review.
